

## VOTING METHOD

All votes taken by the Board will be by “ayes” and “nays,” and will be recorded in the official proceedings of the meeting.

To comply fully with state law, roll call votes will be made on resolutions pertaining to the following:

1. Purchase or sale of real or personal property
2. Employment of any school employee
3. Payment of any debt or claim
4. Adoption of any textbook
5. Any action on which a Board member requests a roll call vote
6. All actions referred to below requiring more than a majority vote of membership for passage

The following actions, under law, require either a three-fourths or two-thirds affirmative vote of full membership for passage:

1. Re-employment of a teacher against the Superintendent’s recommendation
2. Refusal to give a continuing contract to a teacher if such has been recommended by the Superintendent
3. Certain actions relating to bond issues and operating levies
4. Certain actions relating to transfer of funds

For passage, all other actions will require an affirmative vote by a majority of those present and voting.
