INDIVIDUALIZED INSTRUCTION

The Columbia Local Board of Education will encourage those programs, instructional arrangements, and form of class instruction that will provide opportunities for a student to progress in school at his/her own pace to attain the highest achievement possible for him/her as an individual. Such programming allows for individualized instruction.

The individual plan determined for each child will be developed in accordance with the student's individual needs. The plan will provide for frequent reevaluation of the students' needs, progress, and the effectiveness of the program being offered.

Individualized instruction demands evaluation and measurement of student progress as much as other forms of instruction. Evaluation will be tailored according to the nature of the instruction, the established pupil performance objectives, and the subject objectives established for the course in which the individualized instruction is being provided.
