COMMUNITY INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES

Helping each student develop to his/her full potential and to become a citizen contributing to the welfare of this community are important objectives of the Columbia Local School District's educational program.

Toward these ends, the Board will encourage administrative and instructional personnel to work with the community as one of the educational resources at their command. The administration will direct a community instructional resources program designed to involve the citizens, the institutions, and the environment of our community in the education of its children.

The Superintendent will have supervisory control over the community resources program, which will include the school volunteer service. Members of the staff and of the community will be encouraged to offer their ideas and services through the channels which the administration develops.

At least annually, the Superintendent will report to the Board on the involvement and effectiveness of the community resource program.
