COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION MAKING

Citizen's Advisory Committee: Organization and Dissolution

The Board of Education may from time to time initiate citizens' advisory committees to study matters pertaining to the school district. Such committee will deal with specific areas identified and recognized by school officials.

The function of each citizens' advisory committee will be clearly defined at the outset, and will be considered fulfilled when the committee has made its final report through the Superintendent to the Board of Education. At that point, a decision will be made to terminate or extend the committee's functions.

Advisory Assemblies

Advisory assemblies of citizens may be convened from time to time by action of the Board of Education or the local Superintendent. The purposes of the assemblies will be:

- 1. to provide for two-way communication between the school district representatives and the citizens of the district;
- 2. to encourage and strengthen support for the schools; and
- 3. to provide response from the community as a basis for decision making.
