VIDEO CAMERAS ON SCHOOL BUSES

- 1. Video cameras will be used on any bus owned by the Columbia School District.
- 2. Video cameras will be used exclusively to monitor student behavior. It is not necessary, however, to use a videotape as evidence in a disciplinary hearing.
- 3. The fleet operations manager and the mechanic are the only District employees authorized to install or remove tapes from the on-board cameras.
- 4. The fleet operations manager and the driver of the bus on which the taping occurred are authorized to review the tape. Any administrator, the stuent, and the parents of a student facing discipline are also authorized to view the tapes.
- 5. The videotapes will be erased and reused unless a disciplinary action is considered. The videotape will be reused once the disciplinary action is concluded.
